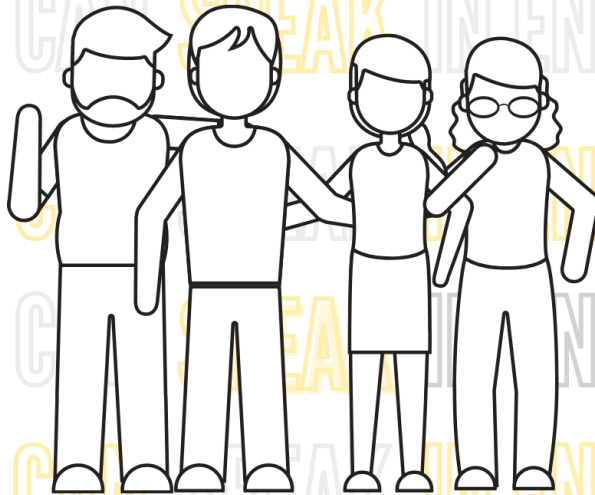

### **Lesson no. 04 Type of sentence.**

Frist we should know about sentence what it contain and what is part of sentence.

#### **4.1 What is sentence?**

A sentence means a group of words. A sentence has subject, verb, object and other words. It express a complete idea as statement or asks a question.

Subject and predicate :

The subject is the thing or person being talked in the such as the action it performs as described by the verb, or the state of being as indicated by the verb.

Anjali plays a game on the ground.

1] Subject : Anjali.

who plays? Ask question to verb by 'who'.

2] Predicate : plays a game on the ground.

Remaining all words verb, object and other words.

Other parts of predicate :

Verb : plays.

It show action find it after subject.

Object : a game.

What plays? Ask question to verb by 'what'.

Other words : on the ground.

Remaining all extra words.

Note : we can make sentence without object and other words.

Anjali plays a game.

Anjali plays.

Some other sentence :

He writes a letter to his mother.

He writes a letter.

He writes.

They are singing a song in class.

They are singing a song.

They are singing.

Above both sentence are meaningful without object and other words.

Here subject we consider 'you'. Above sentence are imperative sentences.

## **4.2 Type of sentence.**

There are four type of sentence. Sentences may be classified according to the purpose of the speaker or writer. The four principal purposes of a sentence are described below.

### **1] Assertive sentence/ declarative.**

(a statement)

The declarative sentence is used to make a statement of fact, wish, intent, or feeling.

ex. I have seen that movie twice.

I wish I could go on the picnic.

Ajay is a student.

She lives in a big city.

We are going to college.

Useful sentence for conversation repeat each loudly.

I am watching movie.

She likes hollywood films.  
My mobile is working properly.  
I am talking about my job.  
Rehan is going to office now.  
He is trying to get chance.  
They were playing a game yesterday.  
We loves to play a cricket.  
Anjali eats everything.  
I can speak English well.

## **2] Imperative sentence.**

(a command)

The imperative sentence is used to state a command, request, or direction. The subject is always "You," even though it may not be expressed in the sentence.

ex. (You) Be on time for dinner.

(You) Open the window, please.

Please lend me your book. (a request)

Go to your room. ( an order)

Have a good time at the picnic.(a wish)

Useful sentence for conversation repeat each loudly.

Please give a chance to do job.

Please help me.

Come here and give me a pen.

Keep quit. Don't make noise.

Come on time in office.

Close the door.

Shut your mouth.

Don't call me again.

Complete your work.

Please talk in English.

Please come to my party.

Please join to us.

Sit down and do your work.

### **3] Interrogative sentence.**

(a question)
